<u>Department of Health Services Announces</u> <u>2008 Average Private Pay Rate</u>

The Department of Health Services has announced the Average Private Pay Rate (APPR) for 2008. The APPR is the number used in calculating the penalty associated with the transfer of non-exempt assets for purposes of qualifying for Long Term Care Medi-Cal. The 2008 APPR is \$5,496.00. The DHS had previously announced that the Community Spouse Resource Allowance (CSRA) has been increased to\$104,400.00 for 2008 and the Monthly Minimum Maintenance Needs Allowance (MMMNA) was increased to \$2,610.00 for 2008.

State Senator Introduces Bill To Outlaw Non-Lawyer Medi-Cal Planners!

On January 31, 2008, State Senator Alquist introduced SB 1136, which would add Welfare and Institutions Code § 10003, which would provide that any non-attorney who charges a fee to represent or aid an applicant in the procurement of public social services shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. This would include services to assist a person in qualifying for Long Term Care Medi-Cal. The purpose of this bill is likely to discourage the misinformation that is being disseminated by many persons, including many annuity and insurance salesmen. However, this bill may go too far, as it would eliminate the services provided by many former eligibility workers as well as force many non-profits and public service organizations to stop providing these types of services.

Update

SB 1136 has been withdrawn from consideration at this time. It is unknown whether it will be brought back for consideration later this year or in future years.
